\$500, for money spent on certain energy-saving improvements to your home. The Owens Corning Basement Finishing System™ is considered a qualifying product under this act.

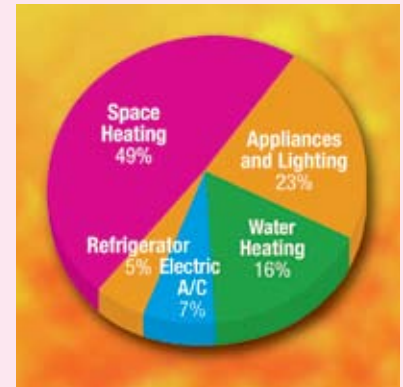
Qualifying purchases must be made between January 1, 2006, and December 31, 2007. The credit applies to income tax forms filed in 2007 or 2008.

HOW TO GET THE TAX CREDIT

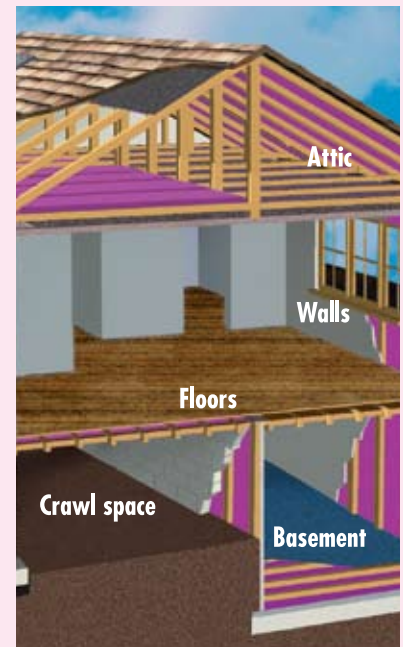
After purchasing the Basement Finishing System™, make sure to obtain a copy of the *Owens Corning Manufacturer's Certification Statement for the Energy Policy Act of 2005* from your Certified Installer or Designer. Copies are also available for download at www.owenscorning.com. You should keep this form, along with receipts proving that you paid for the qualifying products.
